Collecting evidence from my past

What is a birth certificate?

A birth certificate is a very special document that records all of the information about a baby when they are born. Every baby has their own special birth certificate.

We can use our birth certificate to find out:

- our first name;
- our middle name;
- our surname;
- our birthday;
- our gender;
- our mother's name;
- our father's name;
- the date we were born;
- where we were born;
- our address...

Science:

I know you all love experiments!

And hopefully this one won't be as hard on the arm as the last one!!

Here's another science experiment that you can do in your kitchen.

Make a Ghost Glove

YOU WILL NEED

- vinegar
- baking soda
- a glass
- a surgical glove.....(plenty of these around!)



Method

Pour three tablespoons (45ml) of vinegar into the glass.

Spoon two teaspoons (10 ml) of baking soda into the glove. Hold the glove by the wrist

and shake the baking soda down into the fingers.

Holding the fingers of the glove shut, stretch the wrist of the glove over the mouth of the glass.

Pull the glove up straight to let the baking soda fall into the vinegar and observe what happens.

The Science Bit

As the baking soda reacts with the vinegar, it forms bubbles that inflate the glove. When sodium bicarbonate combines with acetic acid, they form carbonic acid, which, in the second part of the reaction, divides into carbon dioxide and water. The carbon dioxide bubbles up, inflating the glove. At the end sodium acetate is left in the jar.
