Here's a science experiment that you can do in your kitchen.

All you need is:

1 raw egg

A clear glass or glass jug Enough white vinegar to cover the egg

Leave the egg in vinegar for two days. Vinegar is an acid, so over time it will dissolve the calcium carbonate in the egg shell. Calcium is what makes the shell hard. Have a look at this link to see what you can do with your egg. (double click icon to open file)
